Restless Pines is pleased to welcome you back to sport & competition by offering several training dates for hunters and jumpers this fall.

We endeavour to promote the well being of our equestrian community through a safe and compliant return to our sport and competitions. Guidelines will be followed in keeping with our regulatory bodies to protect our equestrian community and halt the spread of Covid 19.

We welcome horses and riders of all levels and our mission is to provide a venue that allows horses and riders to gain experience and develop their skills in a safe and welcoming environment.

We are happy to be able to welcome outside competitors to our fall training shows! As we have enjoyed a return to sport and now return to competition we will follow the guidelines set out to us by our provincial government to comply with current Covid 19 protocols.

Limited Spectators - competitors are restricted to one rider per horse plus two support people and coach. Those attending must be named on entry form, and all waivers signed by all. Upon arrival to the venue, attendance will be verified to the list of names provided by entrants and a Daily COVID Checklist will be required to be signed by all.

Dogs are not allowed access to the venue.

There will be no canteen or beverages available. Be prepared, bring your own food and beverages and you will be required to take your garbage with you when you leave.

There will be no water tap available for horses so please remember to bring potable water. The stable area is not available to any persons or animals attending the competition.

You are advised to bring your own Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Social distancing must be demonstrated at all times. Masks to be worn IF social distancing cannot be maintained.

Parking - We will be using the new outdoor competition ring and surrounding area (250' x 1000') as well as original parking area so we can have trailers and competitors adequately spaced.

Washrooms - Portable Toilets and hand washing stations will be available on the grounds.

Entries & waivers to be emailed with payment by etransfer by the Wednesday before each competition.

Hunter Divisions - \$50 per division - 2 o/f, 1 u/s per division Jumper Classes - \$25 per class Hack & Novice - \$40 per division

All entry forms must be signed by horse owners, competitors and person responsible for horse. A parent / guardian signature required for all riders under the age of 19.

The Restless Pines Training Shows, its Management, Organizing Committee, Officials or Show Staff are in no way responsible for accident, injury or damage to any rider, exhibitor, spectator, groom, attendant, trainer or other employee; or animals, nor theft, loss or damage to animals, vehicles or equipment.

October schedule will be determined after the September shows once we know if we need one or two days to run the competition.

All walk trot and walk trot canter divisions will have two pleasure and one equitation class each.

The horse/ pony hack division - 3 classes, 2 pleasure & 1 road hack. Pole hunter 3 classes: 2 o/f, 1 u/s

All hunter divisions have 2 over fences and one under saddle per division. All rounds will be run back to back in threes.

Please note there is no time allowed in 1st round of the welcome jumpers to allow time for young horses and riders to ride safely through the course.

All novice divisions in the indoor arena all other divisions in outdoor arena.

Competition numbers must be worn at all times – **ring numbers will not** be given out until all entries are paid in full.

Divisions will be combined if not enough entries at closing date. All heights will be offered if there are entries to promote riders moving up.
